VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

- Our volunteer orientation classes are held the second Saturday of every month from 10 - 11 am.
- No prior registration is required, we just ask that you be on time to the class so we don't have to backtrack. If you're more than 10 minutes late you will be asked to come to the next class the following month.
- All Volunteers must be 16+ unless their parent or guardian is present with them. No volunteers under 12 allowed.
- You need closed-toe shoes and clothes that can get furry and dirty. Please avoid flip-flops, bare-midriff shirts, or apparel with inappropriate sayings or logos. We'd hate to ask someone to leave if dressed inappropriately.
- New shelter volunteers will be limited in what they are allowed to do until
 they have completed enough hours to be familiar with the protocol and
 schedule of shelter happenings. Initial volunteers may help socialize cats,
 prepare litterboxes, stock supplies, assist with basic janitorial duties, and
 wash dishes and crates, etc. at the discretion of the shelter staff.
- Before being allowed to walk dogs, you must complete a minimum of 4 volunteer hours.
- Shelter Orientation is a brief over view of how the shelter runs, our schedule, available volunteering opportunities, and what we expect from people that choose to volunteer.
